

MILITARY TRAINED MLT APPLICANTS

Active military personnel enrolled in the military Medical Laboratory Specialist course will be allowed to sit for the MLT(ASCP) certification examination within the last three weeks of Phase II training as long as the following guidelines are met:

- Must be in good standing.
- Upon submission of application and application fee the Applicant must submit a letter on military letterhead from the Program Director documenting expected completion date of Phase II training and the date of graduation.

When eligibility has been established by the ASCP Board of Registry the candidate will receive the following:

- Admission letter with the beginning eligibility date within three weeks prior to graduation.
- A three (3) month window of eligibility.

Candidates will schedule an appointment for the date and time of their choice within the three month window of eligibility.

IMPORTANT: Students will be permitted to test prior to graduation; however, their examination scores **will not** be released until a certificate of completion from the program and an official transcript documenting completion of the academic requirements are received in the Board of Registry office.
